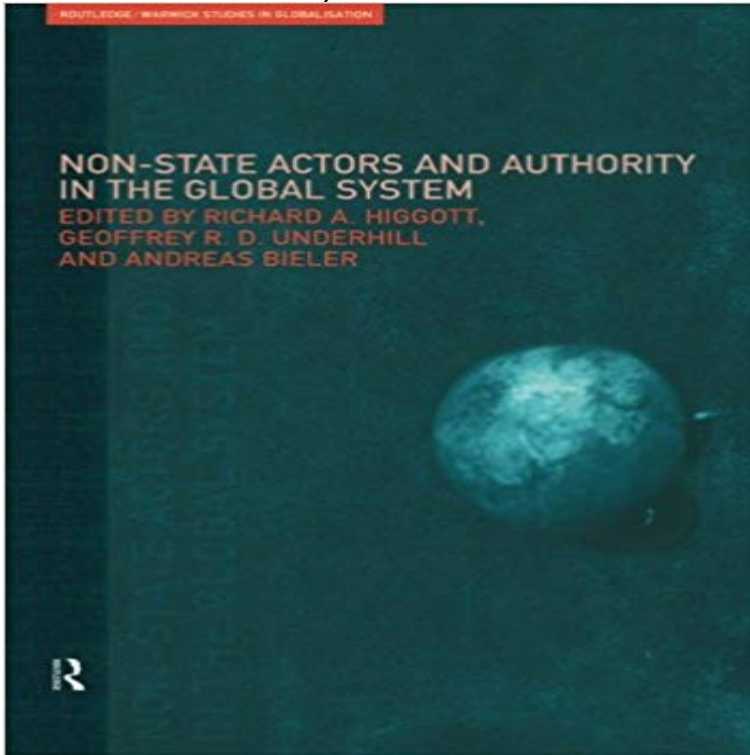


Non-State Actors and Authority in the Global System (Routledge Studies in Globalisation)
