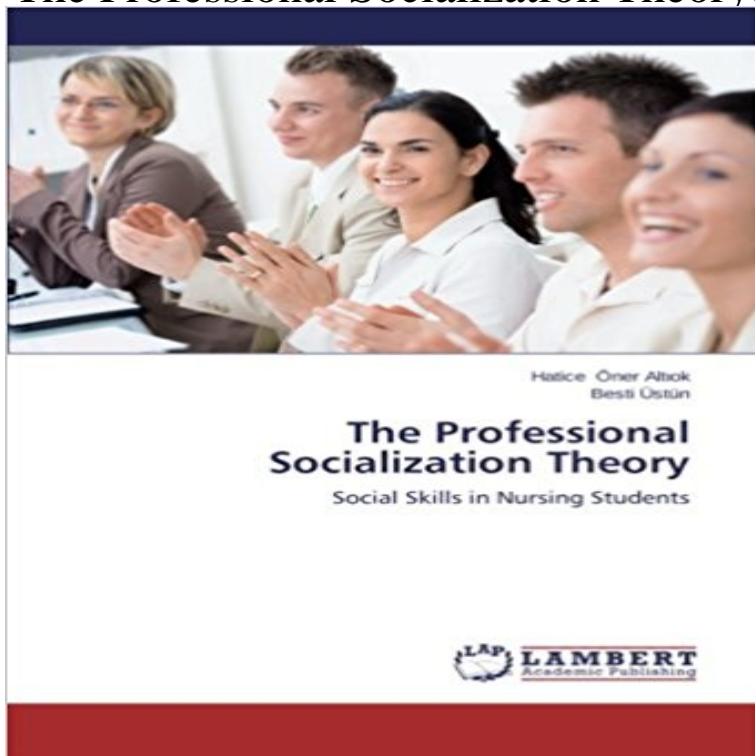


The Professional Socialization Theory: Social Skills in Nursing Students
