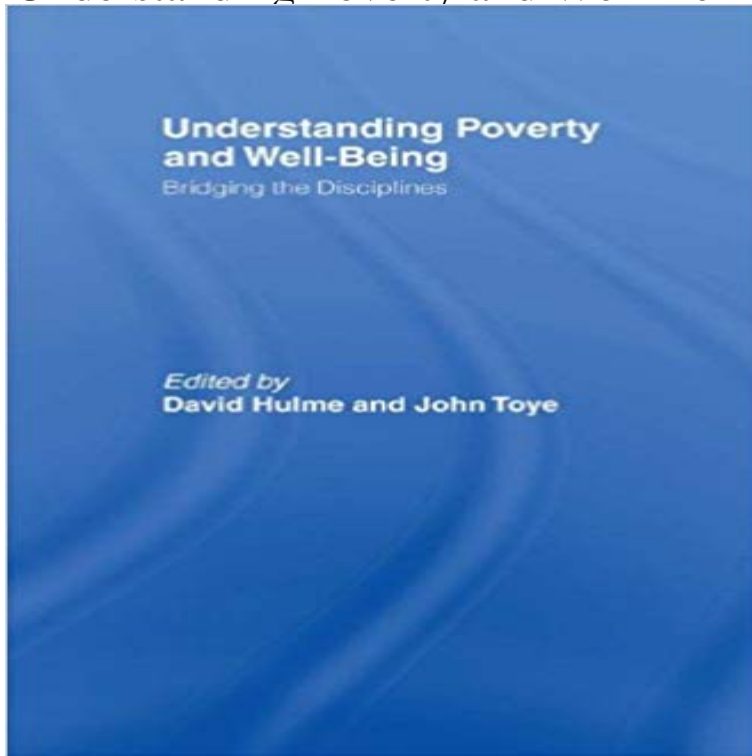


Understanding Poverty and Well-Being: Bridging the Disciplines
