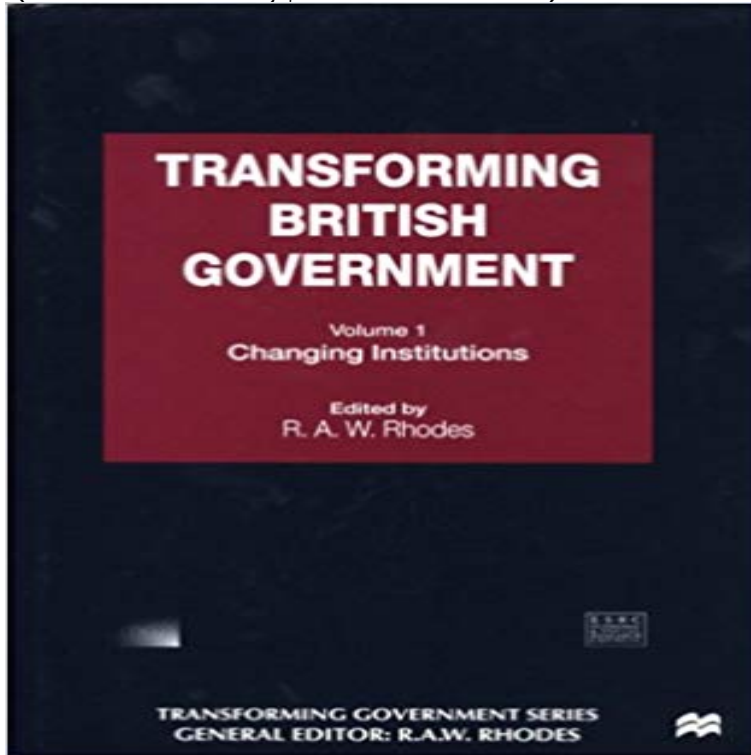


Transforming British Government, Volume I: Changing Institutions (Transforming Government)
