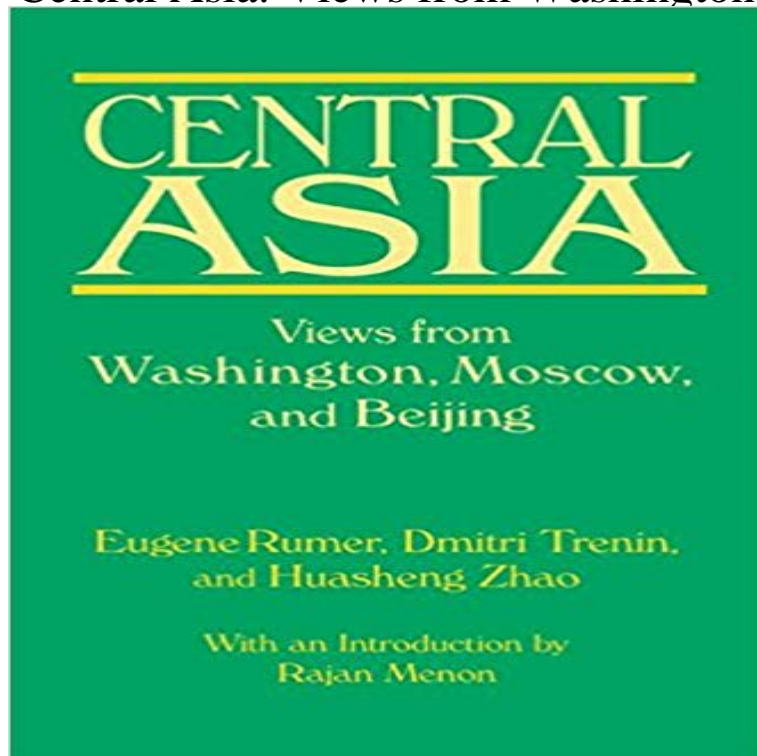


## Central Asia: Views from Washington, Moscow, and Beijing
