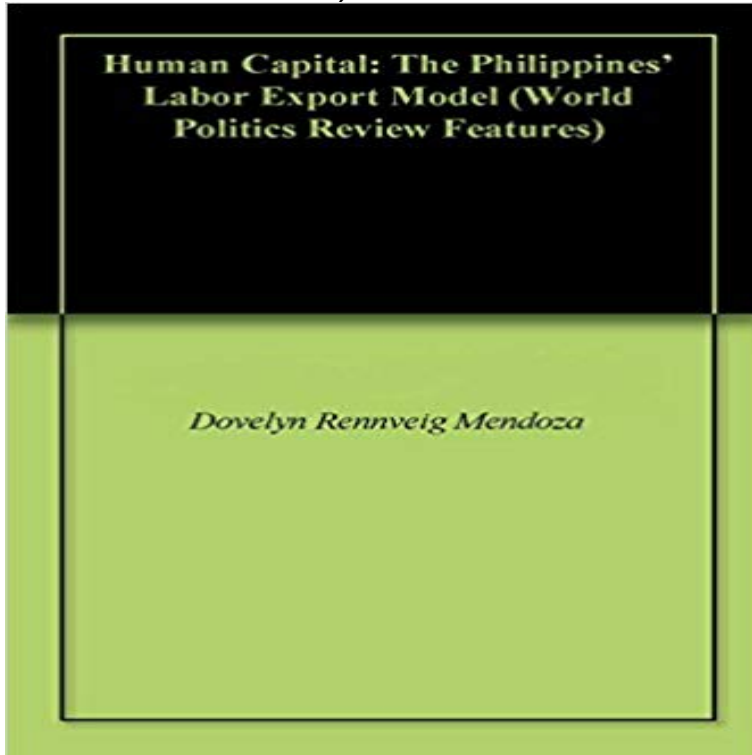


Human Capital: The Philippines Labor Export Model (World Politics Review Features)
