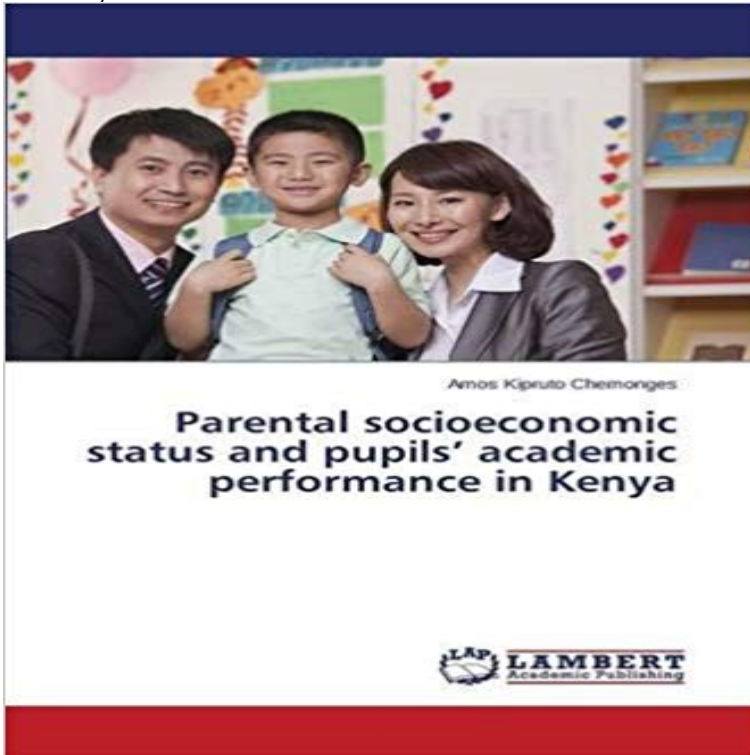


Parental socioeconomic status and pupils academic performance in Kenya

A researcher, Laosa, had posted as follows: The educational achievement gap has deep root; it is evident very early in child's lives; even before they enter schools. Socio-economic differences -such as health and nutrition status, home environments that provide access to academically related experiences, mobility rates, and financial assets can certainly influence academic achievements (Laosa, 2005:5)
