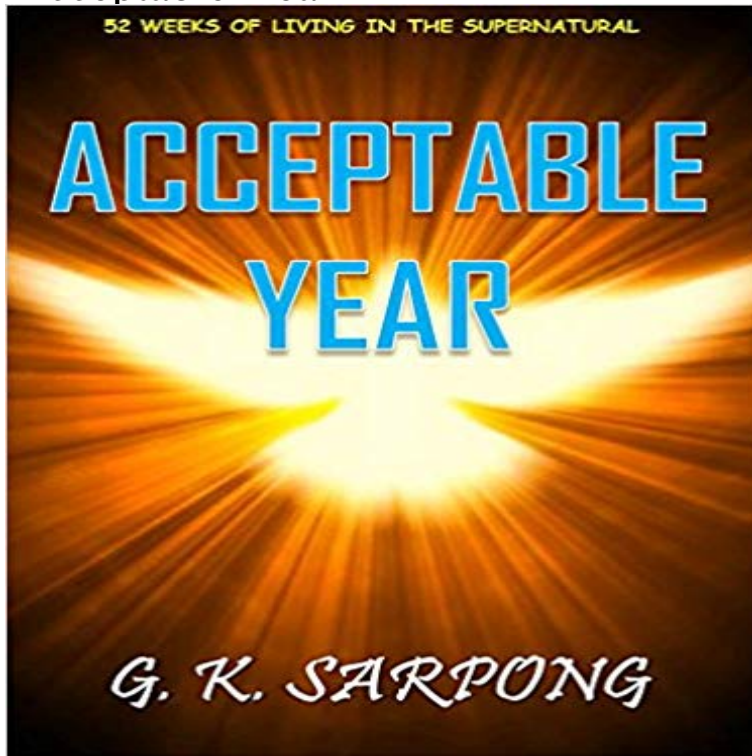


Acceptable Year
